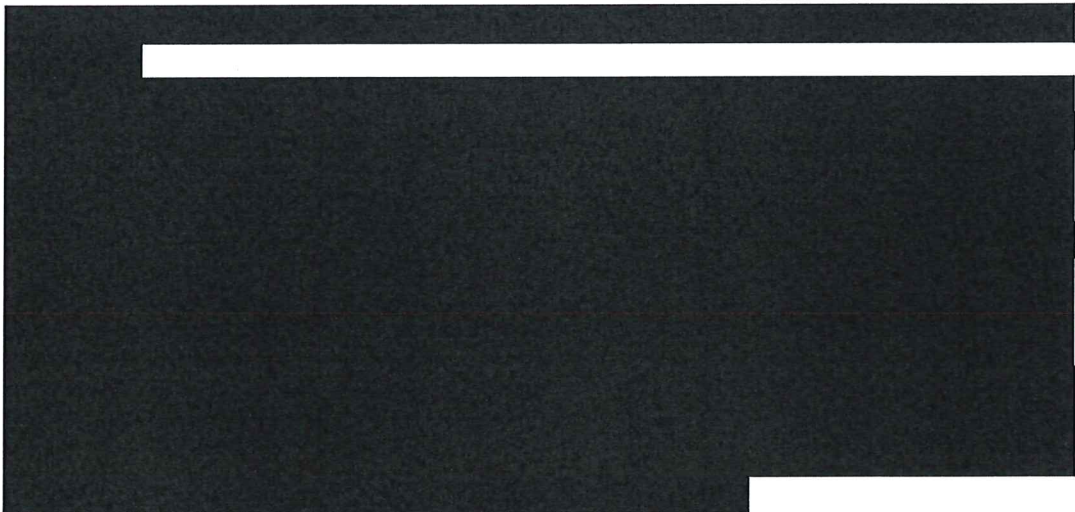


High Level Comments on the First Presidency Compromise Text on the DMA

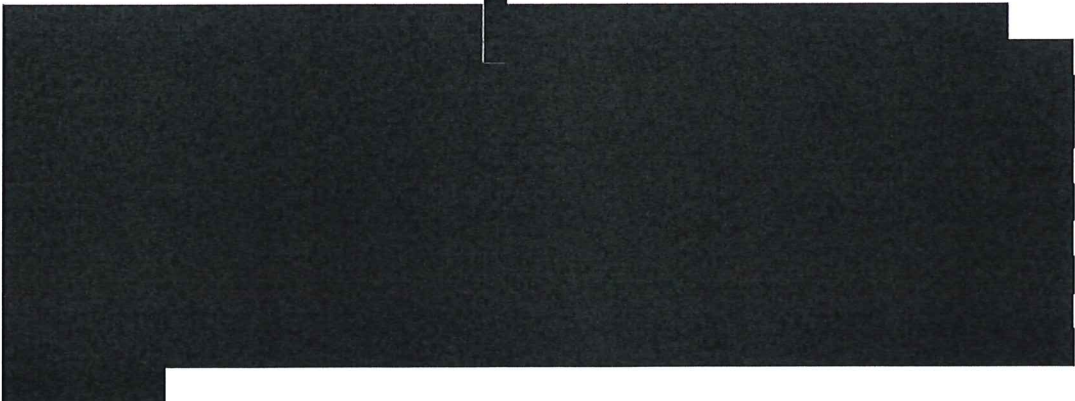

In the spirit of continuing that constructive dialogue, Facebook respectfully lays out its high level comments on the first Presidency compromise text. As a company that will very likely fall in the scope of the DMA, Facebook would like to inform the ongoing deliberations among Member States from a more practical point of view of an entity that will have to ensure compliance with the provisions of this significant proposal.
