DOT Europe, the trade association representing a broad range of leading internet companies in Europe, would like to take the opportunity to write you with regards to the proposed Regulation on a Single Market for Digital Services (DSA).

As the proposal is considered by the European Parliament and the European Council, we want to remain a constructive stakeholder and help support your work on this crucial piece of legislation. It is in that spirit would like to share with you comments for your consideration on matters which we believe to be crucial for the future of the European Single Market and the digital ecosystem as a whole.

The DSA is an opportunity to strengthen the EU Internal Market as it offers the opportunity to update the horizontal rules governing the online ecosystem. However, the DSA was not drafted with the intention to solve all issues encountered online so we urge you to ensure the text remains focused. Preserving the country of origin principle is of the utmost importance if we want legislation to be interpreted consistently and foster the emergence of European champions. Coherence between the DSA and other pieces of legislation will be key to the future of tech regulation in order to avoid creating legal uncertainty.

We include for your consideration our detailed comments on the file, and remain at your disposal for further questions or meetings in the future.
